Description:

The training of personnel for this enterprise was done in August 2012 at the Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI) at DOST, Bicutan. After the procurement of equipment, the Complementary Food Project of Food Technology Center (FTC) of Xavier University started production of complementary food in February 2013 for the barangays of Cagayan de Oro City. Since last year, It has also produced the infant food for municipalities in Misamis Oriental such as Talisayan, Magsaysay and Gingoog City. To date more than 75,000 30-grams packs have been produced and distributed for the different feeding programs in Misamis Oriental. Recently, FTC has developed a new products from the original formulation of BIGAS-MONGGO-SESAME. This is a kroepcke type chips and is targeted for toddlers and older children. The complementary food production is a technology developed by FNRI-DOST which intends to reduce the occurrence of underweight in 6 to 36 months old infant and children through feeding with instant food blend and snack foods. The package is complemented with nutrition education among mothers and caregivers. The complementary goods has been made available in the localities through equipment grant and technical assistance of FNRI-DOST and DOST X. The adopters like LGUs, NGOs, private organizations/foundations and academic institutions implement the program locally and assure its sustainability.
